How to Project the Desktop

- Use Screen 1 to Log in
- Tap on Screen 2, on the bottom right corner select the more options icon 
- Select **Projector On** button at the bottom center of your screen
- Once projector is on, select the **Close** button on the right side of your screen
- At the bottom center of your screen, select the orange plus icon 
- On the bottom left side of your screen, select the **PC Desktop** icon
- You should be able to see your desktop screen on the projector
- To project what you have on Screen 1, drag and drop from Screen 1 to Screen 2 using the computer mouse
- To exit the system you are currently using, go to the system window on the bottom left, select the arrow and press the X icon on the bottom right
- Select more options icon , select the **Projector Off** button at the center of your screen
- Navigate to Screen , please **do not forget to Sign out** before you leave the classroom

How to Control the Volume

- On the bottom right of Screen 2, select the more options button 
- On the bottom left corner of Screen 2, you will locate the volume control bar
- Select the Close button on the right side of your screen
- To control your volume on other extensions (PC Desktop, Airplay, or other systems) on the main desktop window, select the arrow on the bottom left of the window you are currently using, the volume icon will be at the center
- Select the icon to toggle the bar right or left depending on your need
