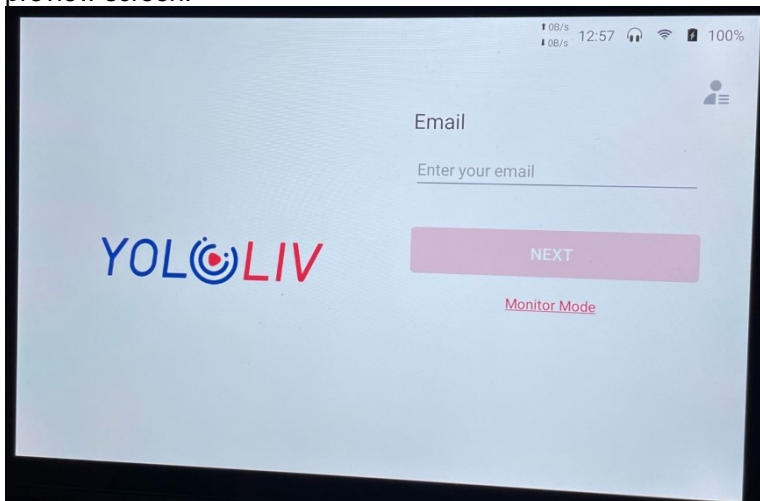
Equipment

These rooms are equipped with the following equipment:

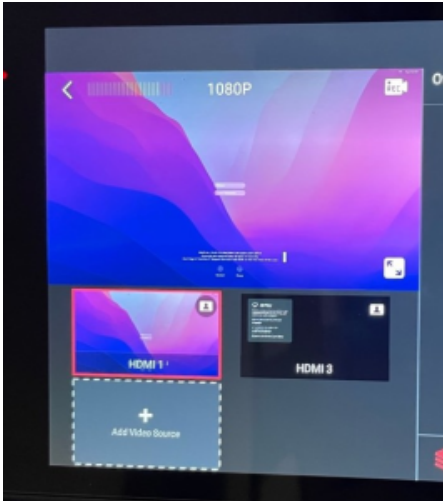
- Projector
- Windows computer
- Mouse and Keyboard
- Apple TV
- Sound through Ceiling/Wall Speakers

Using the Touch Panel

- When walking into the space, the touch panel is located near the teacher's computer.
 - If the device has been powered off and is on the login screen, tap the "Monitor Mode" link.
 - If the device is already on the preview screen, you can simply select your input option by tapping the preview screen.

- On the next screen, you should see both the computer and Apple TV inputs showing on the left side.

- In order to have the video showing, tap on the cog wheel in the lower-right corner of the screen.
 - Turn on the toggle switch next to "Program Out"

- Tap on the preview window below the large view to select the input you want to show.
 - HDMI 1 (Computer)
 - The computer is located on the teacher's desk in the classroom.
 - HDMI 2 (Apple TV)
 - If the Apple TV video is not showing, use the remote on the desk to wake up the device.
- After the computer screen is displayed, enter your username and password to log in.
 - If using Zoom, select the Microsoft LifeChat or Dell Monitor webcam
