

Academic Structure Glossary

Term	Definition
Academic Level	The level of an educational objective that students can pursue at Lynn, such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Undergraduate, Graduate, Doctoral, Non-Degree
Academic Unit	A Workday organization type that represents a unit of the institution, such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> College of Business and Management Conservatory of Music
Superior Academic Unit	The overall structure of the institution academic units. Subordinate academic units inherit role assignments and business process definitions from superior academic units. Example: Lynn University is the superior academic unit for the College of Arts and Sciences and the College of Business and Management. Both schools inherit business process definitions from Lynn University but it is possible to customize business processes for each college.
Academic Unit Hierarchy	A group of academic units that enable roll-up reporting.
Academic Unit Sub type	The sub type identifies whether an academic unit or academic unit hierarchy is a department, school, college, university, or another type.
