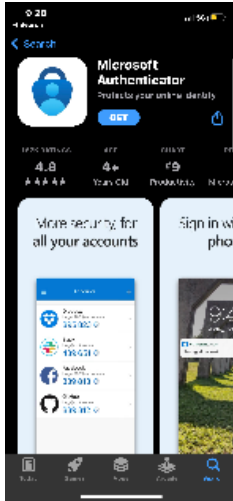


# Password State Azure MFA Setup Process

Steps for Multi-Factor Authentication using the Microsoft Mobile Phone Authenticator App for Password State.

## Step-by-step guide

1. Download the **Microsoft Mobile Phone Authenticator App** from your mobile phone app store.

2. On your Lynn Issued device, navigate to [lupass.lynn.edu](http://lupass.lynn.edu) and sign in to your account.

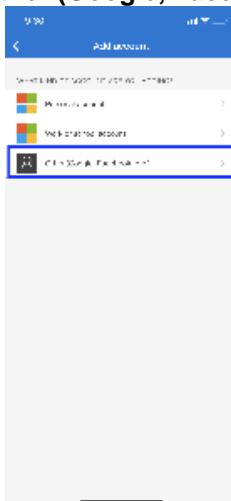
